MEET THE TEACHER/PARENT ORIENTATION EVENINGS

Dear Parents,

In order to maximize the opportunities for parents to meet teachers, particularly in families of more than one child, we are scheduling meetings over the course of two evenings. Briefly, teachers of Grades 1 through 4 will meet with parents on Thursday, September 13, 2007; teachers of Grades 5 through 8 and all "Special" teachers (Art, Spanish, Gym, Technology, Library, Computer, etc.) will meet with parents on Monday, September 17, 2007. "Specials") Unless otherwise noted, teachers will meet with parents in their regular classrooms at the specific times/days noted: Parents may go directly to classrooms using the ASR front entrance.

B. Monday, September 17, 2007 (Grades 5 through 8 and Specials)

GRADE FIVE.....6:30 to 7:10

Mrs. Kahn (5A, Rm. 132) and Mrs. Benazzi (5B, Rm. 134) will meet with their respective classes initially, allowing time during the latter part of the session to speak with the parents of the "other" 5th Grade class regarding their respective curriculum.

GRADE SIX.....7:15 to 7:55

Mrs. Grygo (6B, Rm. 135) and Mrs. Galvani (6A, Rm. 126) will meet parents in the Parish Hall at 7:15, at which time the 6th Grade curriculum will be reviewed. Miss Meserole will also be in attendance to discuss the Math curriculum and Miss Maher will discuss the Social Studies curriculum. At this time, Mr. Bott will also address any Science curriculum overview questions. Parents may visit the individual classrooms of 6A/6B to view the room and discuss any additional matters with teachers between 8:30 and 9:15.

GRADE SEVEN.....8:00 to 8:50

Miss Maher (7A,Rm.131) and Mrs. DeNino (7B,Rm.130) will meet with their respective parents and provide an overview of the curriculum as well as a review of guidelines and procedures. Mrs. Grygo and Miss Meserole will assist with an overview of the Math curriculum as needed. Mrs. Badger will be visiting both classes between 8:00 and 8:35 to provide a brief overview of the Science curriculum. At 8:35 PM 7A & 7B parents will switch rooms so that Mrs. DeNino may review the Social Studies curriculum and Miss Maher, the Language Arts curriculum.

GRADE EIGHT.....8:50 to 9:30

Mrs. Badger (8A,Rm. 137) and Miss Meserole (8B,Rm. 136) will meet with their respective parents to provide an overview of the curriculum as well as guidelines and procedures for the 8th grade, including matters pertaining to High School Entrance Applications, testing and Senior activities throughout the year. Mrs. Grygo will present a brief overview of the Math curriculum to 8A, Miss Meserole to 8B. Mrs. DeNino will also make a brief presentation about the Language Arts Curriculum to both classes during this time


Mrs. Galvani – Rm. 126 (Spanish) -Available All Evening except 7:15 to 7:55
